

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF HENLOW ORCHARD AS A TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN

The Clerk has previously corresponded with the applicants of the above, in August and September 2010, as they had wrongly stated on their website during this period *“We were approached in July by Henlow Parish Council to list Henlow Orchard as a Village Green Open Space....”* The Clerk had written to the applicant on a number of occasions to demand that this false statement be removed from their web site, as the Parish Council had never discussed this matter at that time, nor had ever approached the applicant as wrongly claimed.

This incorrect statement was finally removed in late September 2010. However the same false statement has now reappeared on the applicant’s web site ‘saynototownfarmdevelopment.com’ on the ‘Orchard Restoration’ page.

The Members unanimously agreed at their Full Council meeting held on 13th June 2011, that the Clerk write to the applicant again demanding that the false statement be removed from their web site. Should the applicant fail to respond to HPC’s demand he was also authorised to seek legal advice to ensure the inaccurate statement does not remain in the public domain.
